It is not only a matter of building vehicles, but also of controlling and maintaining them. Transport operations must be planned, coordinated and monitored in order to get people and materials to their destination safely, punctually and efficiently.

Business, Administration & Management

In the office, everything revolves around the organisation of processes, scheduling and clerical or order processing. Typical areas are, for example, administration, marketing and advertising, insurance, human resources or real estate management. In sales and distribution, the focus is on goods and services of all kinds. In order to be able to plan and coordinate business activities, business and legal principles play a decisive role - just as in accounting or tax matters.

Here, some of the professionals are distinguished by the fact that they wear a uniform, e.g. in the police or in air and shipping traffic. The tasks in the service sector range from the execution of concrete service offers to planning and pricing.
